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
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## 5.4: Special New Innovative Initiatives or Ideas Adopted in the College. (Other than in Sr. No. 5.2)

Secondly to facilitate students with upgraded and ICT library resources this college purchased the equipments of about Rs 20 lacs to facilitate the students.











#### 2. Book Bank

#### 3. G. B. Pant Memorial Distinguished Lecture Series



#### 4. Interaction session with the students of post-Graduate classes.



## Report of interaction and counseling session for PG students

A Series of interaction and counseling session for outgoing PG students were organized in the Govt. college Rampur Bushahr w.e,f. 3June 2024 to 6 June 2024 (4days) for the internalization of quality teaching -learning and conducive ambience in the campus for the holistic development of the students in both morning and evening session. All the sessions of this interaction programme were chaired by principal, Dr. Pankaj Basotia, G.C.Rampur. In this interaction and counseling session Coordinators of this programme, staff members and students of PG fourth semester from various department i.e. Botany, Chemistry Zoology, Commerce, Economics, English, Geography, Hindi, History, Mathematics, Political Science, Sociology and PGDCA participated.

Objectives:-

The main objective of this programme was to interact with the outgoing students to understand the fulfillment of their interest area, redressal of academic and pedagogical problems, encourage them to share their experiences in college as well as guide students wherever they need. So every participant got a chance to speak in this interaction session.

#### Strengths:-

Most of the Students were very happy for this interaction session and shared their views, challenges, experiences, feelings, suggestions etc.

Most of the Students appreciated college library, reading room as well as the increased timing of library (8; 00 am -8:00 pm) which facilitated adequate space and time for the students for studying as they could utilize their precious time in reading in an ideal environment with increased seating capacity. Some students appreciated co-curricular activities in the college such as cultural programs, academic programmes, sports activities, educational tour, field visits as these activities provide with an ideal opportunity for Experiential and participative learning which ensures effective curriculum delivery etc. Many students admired their hostel life and considered it very important for their overall development and learning. Most of the students were happy for nice behavior of teachers while teaching, guiding and motivating them.

Students also shared the challenges they were facing in college. The most common among them were lack of teacher for PG classes, lack of rooms for PG classes, lack of standard and advanced books in library, issues related up gradation of Laboratory and issues related to cleanliness and hygiene in toilet etc. Many students also shared that PG students feels neglected in college due to less importance is given to them as compared to U G students. Some students also shared that there are only a few awareness programmes related to various aspects of life and co-curricular activities in college campus which should be increased. Beside this students also shared their heart touching life storey and challenges faced by them for study.

The chairman, Dr. Pankaj Basotia, Principal, G. B. Pant Memorial Govt. College, Rampur listen every students intensively and shared his valuable experiences as well as gave the solutions for the raised problems with his in-depth knowledge and experiences.



The Following suggestions had come from chair, teachers and students:

- Awareness programs related to their career opportunity, life skills, soft skills, values, financial knowledge, health and hygiene, menstruation, sports and games, environment UGC NET etc. Should be promoted among the students.
- Various clubs should be formed in college such as photography club, art and craft club, gardening club, cleanliness and sanitation club etc. and the students should be involved in college administration through these clubs for the effective implementation of the policies.
- Orientation program for student should be organized in college campus in the beginning of new session to make student comfortable with new environment of the institution teachers and various activities of college.
- 4. CSCA of college is needed to be more active and make and prepare an activity calendar in the beginning of every academic session and also collect the feedback of the students and other stake holder at the end of the session or the completion of the degree.
- What's app group of parents should be made in to sharing the student's related information to parents.
- Students also suggested for more smart classroom, dispensary, separate PG block for PG student, Lockers in library, ATM, Indoor Game etc.
- 7. Library should have advanced and standard books for PG Students.
- 8. Laboratories should be well equipped with instruments and equipments.
- Special teacher should be there to teach technical subjects like GIS and remote sensing in geography.

All the students and teachers appreciated the insight and vision of the chair to organize this type of interaction and counseling sessions in this institution for the first time, which were not only fruitful to all the students but for the growth of institution too.
