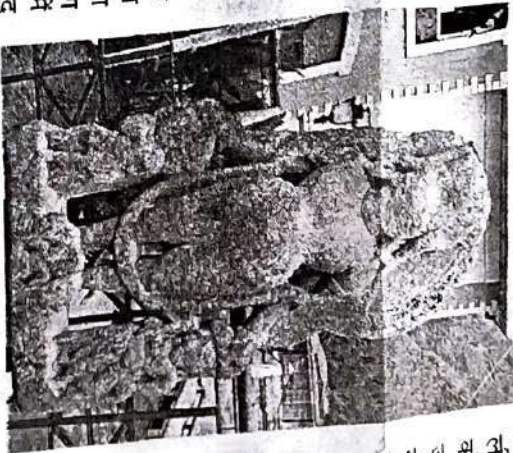

Many questions were asked by the participants that showed that they were keen to know more and more about the dreadful disease. The webinar did helped everyone enhance their information on Cancer.

INTERNSHIP ON “ SAFETY AND GREENER CHEMISTRY LABS.”

Five students of the college named Miss Muskan Sharma, Miss Saloni, Miss Yogmaya, Miss Aishwarya and Mr. Reetvik of the BSc. III year successfully completed three-Month Internship on ‘Safety and Greener Chemistry Labs’, a community Outreach Program under the Mentorship of Dr. Gopi Chand, Asstt. Professor, Department of Chemistry w.e.f. 01st November 2022 to 31st January 2023 and guidance from Indian Cancer Society, Delhi and Guru Angad Dev Teaching Learning Centre, SGTB Khalsa College, University of Delhi under the Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching (PMMMNTT) of Ministry of Education. This internship included survey, media, and fieldwork activities and helped in developing 21st Century skills among the students.

During the course of internship these five students along with mentor teacher Dr. Gopi Chand, visited periodically in five school- Govt. Senior Secondary School Dutt Nagar, Govt. Senior Secondary School Nogle, Govt. Senior Secondary School (Boys) Rampur, Govt. Senior Secondary School (Girls) Rampur and Govt. Senior Secondary School Jakri . The students performed and demonstrated the greener and safer alternate method of doing chemistry practical to 10+1 and 10+2 science students of these schools.

During this course of experiential learning focus was given to minimal uses of chemicals by shifting from macro to micro and spot testing, Greener alternative to qualitative analysis for cations without H₂S and other Sulfur –Containing Compounds, “Double Burette Titration ” method of the volumetric analysis instead of single burette method and use on “Botmel” apparatus for melting point , boiling point and distillation.

NATIONAL LEVEL WEBINAR/WORKSHOP ON “ SAFETY AND GREENER CHEMISTRY LABS.”

A national level webinar/workshop was conducted by the Department of Chemistry on “ Greener and Safer Chemistry Labs.” on dated 19th December 2023 in collaboration with Guru Angad Dev Teaching Learning Centre, SGTB Khalsa College, University of Delhi under the Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching (PMMMNTT) of Ministry of Education, which is a partial requirement for the completion of the internship. This webinar/workshop was conducted in the hybrid mode and 145 students, faculty and lab staff of different schools and colleges have attended and participated in this

webinar/workshop In this webinar the organizing secretary Dr. Gopi Chand delivered a power point presentation on " Mixture Analysis without the use of Hyderogen Sulphate (H_2S)". His intern student, Miss Saloni delivered a power point presentation on "Double Burette Titration ". The intern student Miss Muskan Sharma delivered power point presentation on " an alternate method for the determination of melting point , boiling point and distillation". In the second phase of the workshop the intern students Miss Yogmaya, Miss Aishwarya and Mr. Reetvik of the BSc. III collectively demonstrate and provide hand on practices of these safer and greener alternate method to all the participants in the chemistry laboratory.

EDUCATION TOUR TO RASHTRAPATI NIWAS AT MASHOBRA, SHIMLA, HP.


As the head of institutions were directed by The Director of Higher Education, Himachal Pradesh, Shimla vide letter No-1 DN-III (21)BC(15)15-2021-V-dt 04.04.2023 to make a visit to Rashtrapati Niwas, Mashobra, Shimla. That is why, an educational tour was organized by the department of History for the students of MA. In this tour 32 students of MA 2nd and 4th Sem took part. After doing all cordial formality Prof. Pratibind Pandey and Dr. Vipin Sharma, Assistant Professors of the Department of History leads the tour. Teachers along with students of the Department of History and Political Science start their journey at 7 AM in the morning. The group arrived at 12:15 PM at the destination but due to the VIP visit of some politicians we were denied entry as soon. However, we waited and made an adventure walk through the Adventure Trail attached t the Rastrapati Niwas estate. At about 3 PM we got permission to enter the complex. The Rashtrapati Niwas, Mashobra is a 173-year-old heritage building located in the picturesque surroundings of Mashobra, Himachal Pradesh. The estate has a plinth area of 10,628 sq. ft. and comprises the main building, lawns, orchards and nature trails. This retreat is visited by the President of India every year during summer.

As per directed by the Director of Higher Education under notification no. EDN HE (20) B (15) 15/2021-V-dated 04-04-2023 to arrange the visit at Rashtrapati Niwas located at Chhabra(Mashobra) Shimla With the permission of the head of the institution Department of Political Science organized an educational tour for the students of M.A. After doing all cordial formalities 16 students of department took part in an educational tour. The educational tour was lead under the guidance of Prof. Kapoor Chand and Prof Narender Singh of the Department of Political Science. Teachers and students of political science and history started their journey at 7 A.M. in the morning. The group arrived at 12 P.M.at the destination.



The guides appointed at the Rashtrapati Niwas provided detailed information to the students about the history and importance of the heritage. He told that the building was built at a height of 8000 feet in 1850 by the king of the princely state of Koti. This building is made of wooden frame with dajji wall. The President's residence is spread over 10,628 square feet. The retreat building was taken on lease by lord William from the Raja of Koti. The Raja of koti retained it again in 1886 but in 1895 the Viceroy annexed it. After independence, it was converted into the President's residence. Since then, every year the President of the country comes here to stay for a few days.

राजकीय महाविद्यालय रामपुर बुशैहर ने 15 मई 2023 के इतिहास विभाग ने एमएम के छात्र एवं छात्राओं के लिए एक शैक्षणिक भ्रमण का आयोजन करवाया। इसमें डॉ विपन शर्मा सहायक आचार्य के निर्देशन में लगभग 60 छात्रों ने निरथ में स्थित सूर्य मन्दिर का दौरा किया। मन्दिर के संक्षिप्त इतिहास पर प्रकाश डालते हुए मंदिर पुजारी ने इसकी प्राचीनता एवं किवदंतियों से अवगत कराया। इसके पश्चात डॉ विपन शर्मा जो एक पुरातत्वविद भी है ने मंदिर की वास्तु कला और मूर्ति कला की विस्तृत जानकारी छात्रों को प्रदान की। लगभग 40 फुट ऊंचा यह मंदिर नागर शैली में बना है। गर्भगृह पर एक शिखर बना है, जिसमें चारों दिशाओं की भव्य दीवारों पर भद्रमुख में शिव जी के मुख बने हैं। शिखर पर एक विशाल आमालक बना है साथ ही उसके ऊपर पीतल का कलश एवम चाँदी का छत्र है। गर्भगृह में सूर्य देव की प्रस्तर प्रतिमा स्थापित है। गर्भगृह और गंडप को अंतराल द्वारा जोड़ा गया है। गंडप लगभग 10x10 फुट का है जिसमें विष्णु, शिव परिवार, वरुण, गणेश हरिहर आदि देवी-देवताओं की एकात्म मूर्तियां हैं। गर्भगृह की बाहरी दीवारों पर भी महिषासुरमर्दिनि, ब्रह्मा, शिव परिवार, लक्ष्मी नारायण, गणेश आदि उपासकों के साथ स्थापित किए गए हैं। प्राचार्य डॉ पुष्पा नेगी ने इस तरह की शैक्षणिक दौरो को भविष्य में करवाने के लिए प्रोत्साहित किया।

All the students were roaming in that pheasantry till about 4:30 pm . all the students enjoyed a lot with their friends and respected teacers.



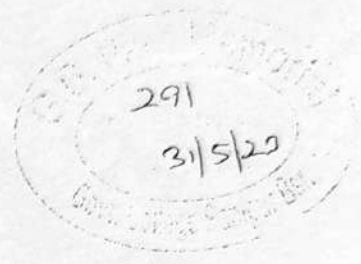



A VISIT TO THE SJVNL HYDRO POWER PROJECT AT JHAKHRI AND VISIT TO MAA BHIMAKALI TEMPLE AT SARAHAN BUSHAHR BY COMMERCE(M.Com) STUDENTS OF GOVT. COLLEGE RAMPUR BUSHAHR






